NOTE:

Times are dependent upon number of Troops/Patrols registered for event and are subject to change.

General information:

- ⇒ EMS and Fire Personnel are assigned to a station to serve as Judges.
- ⇒ Checklists/grading sheets are provided at each station.
- ⇒ Patrols must send 1-2 Scouts to a 911 station to report their situation and provide information on care being provided.
- ⇒ Selected stations will also have optional BONUS questions on selected Scout skills (map reading, ceremonies, etc.).
- ⇒ Scout leaders or other adults **ARE NOT** allowed to assist, travel with, or observe their Scouts during competition.
- ⇒ One WEBLEOS leader or adult **MAY** travel with the WEBELOS scouts but are prohibited from assisting the Scouts during competition.
- ⇒ JUDGES are encouraged to provide general feedback and answer questions if time remains before each rotation is called.
- ⇒ ALL Judges will be asked to meet with the Scouts at the conclusion of each round to provide feedback and answer questions.

NOTE: In prior years, we have been fortunate enough to have Scouts become EMT's and volunteer firefighters based on their experiences at the First Aid meet and their interaction with the judges!

General Scout Information:

1. Patrol Size: Min. 4, Max 6
2. Each station will be 10 minutes in duration.
3. Each Patrol must have its own patrol first aid kit (no sharing). Scout handbooks and/or first aid books are not allowed.
4. Patrols DO NOT leave a station until given the signal to rotate
5. Registration deadline for Scouts: Sat., March 4.
6. WEBELOS & Cub Scouts are scored according to their ability and training.
