

Clothing

- Treat clothes, shoes, and outdoor gear with permethrin: Use gloves and let dry before touching.
- Wear light colored clothes, tuck pants into socks, treat skin & clothes with 20% DEET or essential oils.

- Put clothes in dryer on high immediately after being outdoors or in tick habitat.
- Prompt Tick Check
- Perform tick checks within 2 hours of being outside.
- Check armpits, hair, & groin.

- After, Trinity will donate \$100 to Minsi Trails Council, \$50 of which will go directly to your unit account!











- Minsi Trails Council will be holding a Wood Badge course <u>this summer</u>!

 - August 5th through 9th










- Start early.

- Prepare an estimated budget and get deposit money early!






- Outings
