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The purpose of the First Aid Meet is to test patrol skills and the ability of the patrol to respond as a team to emergency situations. Troops and Venturing Crews are encouraged to participate.

MASKS WILL BE REQUIRED, SO **BE PREPARED** AND BRING YOUR MASK!

In an effort to have more consistency in judging and more realistic scenarios, please read **ALL** of the following information:

### **Patient Info**

#### **Reminder – Patients Needed.**

Troops/Crews are asked to have at least one person per patrol to act as a patient for scenarios. This will allow the Scouts / Venturers to participate in all scenarios. WEBELOS will also be allowed to act as patients this year.

Patients will report to registration for assignment and instructions. WEBELOS will remain with the troop they are associated with.

### **Patrol sizes**

#### **Reminder – Each patrol is to have at least 4 Scouts, but not more than 8.**

Patrols may NOT change Scouts once the event has started.

### **Patrol Names**

### **Patrol Flags**

**Reminder – Patrol names shall be appropriate to Scouting and cannot be changed after registration is completed.**

**Patrol Flags –** should be of original design and may be made of various materials. The Patrol Flag shall be on a pole, but the pole shall be no longer than 6 foot in length. The flag must have the patrol name and troop number on it.

### **Judging**

Scenario judging and test questions will be based on skills covered in the First Aid section of the Scout Handbook and the First Aid Merit Badge Pamphlet.

Scouts will also be evaluated on their ability to perform as a team in providing correct first aid to an injured person.

## Awards

Each Scout, Venturer, judge, and patient will receive a participation patch.

Recognition awards will be given to the top 5 patrols with the highest scores. There will be a District Plaque recognizing the yearly winner of each First Aid Meet. There will be an award given to the winner of the patrol flag competition.

## Uniforms

Scouts, Venturers and Leaders are encouraged to wear their Class A uniform.

## Supplies To Bring

Some suggested items to bring: blankets to be used as a floor covering and in problems; neckerchiefs or triangular bandages; wooden dowel rod to be used for a tourniquet; gauze pads; roller bandages; empty water container (to simulate cleaning of wounds); splints to be made of newspapers, magazines, thin boards, heavy cardboard or commercially made splints; notepad; pen and pencil.

**CELL PHONES/TABLETS ARE NOT TO BE USED DURING TEST AND SCENARIOS!!**

*Their use will result in a score of a zero for that scenario or on the test.*

**REFERENCE BOOKS, STRETCHERS, & COMMERCIAL TOURNIQUETS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

## Volunteers Needed

- Act as patients (Leaders/Parents/Venturers/WEBELOS)
- Judge (qualified persons only please... see note below)
- Assist with tabulating scores

## Registration

Please encourage trained individuals to assist with this event. Judges will assemble for instructions during registration in the kitchen area. **EACH PATROL MUST PROVIDE 1 JUDGE!!!**

Non-participants are reminded to stay behind the caution tape, failure to do so will result in your patrols being deducted points. Adults are encouraged to bring a camp chair to sit on.
